



School Uniform

The School Shop

The school has its own clothes shop which supplies the items of clothing and the bags and accessories that are needed for school and which are not available from any other supplier. The shop also has a limited stock of pre-owned items of uniform which are for resale.

Weekly and Flexi-boarders

The shop is open on Wednesdays 8am – 9am and 3.30pm-6.00pm. If parents cannot visit at this time, they may phone the shop on 0118 976 6910 and leave their order on the answer phone, or email shop@oratoryprep.co.uk. The items will then be delivered to the boarding house and an invoice will be sent home with the child at the end of the week. Please send payment within 10 days of receipt with a cheque made payable to Oratory Trading Ltd. Payment by card is accepted. Details also available for payment by BACS.

Full-time Boarders

The school shop manager will supply the immediate needs of full-time boarders on the evening of their arrival at the start of their first term. Additional clothing will be supplied as needed. Purchases will be added to the end-of-term bill. Please Note

- All games clothing should be clearly marked on the **FRONT left breast or thigh of each garment using 1" labels with child's initial and surname, supplied by the school shop.**
- Watches should have child's name engraved on the back.
- A padlock is more easily identified if it has been engraved with your child's name.
- All day wear is to be clearly named with woven name tapes (sew-on or iron-on).
- Footwear and luggage must be clearly marked with the pupil's name.
- The school cannot take responsibility for the loss of articles, but every attempt will be made to return items that have been clearly marked.
- Collar/shoulder length hair must be clipped back from the face or a hairband worn. Longer hair must be tied back in a ponytail.

Girls' Uniform

Years 3-5

- Lent and Michaelmas – red roll-neck top with navy jumper, a grey skirt, navy tights and blazer
- Summer – navy blue checked summer dress with navy jumper, long white socks and blazer

Year 6

- Lent and Michaelmas – red roll-neck top with navy jumper, a grey skirt, navy opaque tights and blazer
- Summer – navy blue checked summer dress with navy jumper, school short white socks and blazer

Year 7

- Lent and Michaelmas – red roll-neck top with navy jumper, school tartan kilt, navy opaque tights and blazer
- Summer – navy blue checked summer dress with navy jumper, school short white socks and blazer

No. 1 Uniform Years 3-7

- Lent and Michaelmas – replace red roll-neck top with white reverse neck long sleeved blouse
- Summer – usual uniform dress and blazer

Year 8

- Lent and Michaelmas – white three quarter length sleeved reverse neck blouse with navy jumper, a navy skirt, navy opaque tights and blazer.
- Summer – School white ankle socks. (**no trainer socks**).

Girls' Uniform Lists

- 6 pairs plain (school) white socks, knee-length (Years 3-5 summer term)
- 6 pairs plain (school) white turn-over top ankle socks (Years 6-8 summer term)
- hairband and scrunchie in school colours (hair is to be tied back with bands that are navy or red)
- 1 school book bag (Years 3-5 optional for boarders)
- 1 school satchel (Years 6-8 optional for boarders)
- 1 dance leotard and skirt (Years 3-5)
- 1 navy beanie hat with school crest – (optional but must be school issue)

Boys' Uniform

Years 3-5

- Lent and Michaelmas terms – navy roll-neck top, grey jumper with grey shorts, long socks and blazer
- Summer term– royal-blue shirt with grey shorts, grey jumper, long socks and blazer

Year 6-7

- Lent and Michaelmas terms – navy roll-neck top with long grey trousers, grey jumper, short grey socks and blazer
- Summer term– royal-blue shirt with long grey trousers, grey jumper, short grey socks and blazer

No. 1 Uniform Years 3-7

- Lent and Michaelmas terms – replace navy roll-neck top with white shirt and school tie
- Summer term– replace royal-blue shirt with white shirt and school tie

Year 8

- All year – white shirt and school tie with long grey trousers, grey jumper and short grey socks and blazer. Short sleeved white shirt is optional during the summer term.

Sundries – Full-time and Weekly Boarders

All bedding is supplied by the boarding house which includes duvets, duvet covers, fitted sheets, pillows and pillow cases. However, the children are welcome to bring their own duvet covers and matching pillow cases from home. A light single bed sized cosy blanket is also useful. **Please be sure that all personal items are named.**

The children are also welcome to bring posters, pictures from home, teddies – anything that will help them to feel at home. They may also bring mobile phones and tablets etc.

These too must be named please.

All electronics are locked away at night and the children only have access to them for a short time in the evenings and at certain times over the weekends. Friday nights are "Electronic Free Nights" which means the children will not be able to use them at all on that night!

Year 6 from 7:45 – 8:15pm

Years 7 from 8:00 – 8:30pm

Year 8 from 8:00 – 8:45

The list below is for clothes that are worn out of school hours e.g. evenings and weekends.

Please note – The children's laundry is done and returned to them **daily**. They do not require any more clothes than listed. Please do not bring more clothes than these as storage in the boarding house is limited. Please be aware that the school shop does not supply any footwear therefore please ensure you bring all footwear required as listed within this document. **All items must be clearly labelled with your child's name.**

- 1 smart/casual shirt - **Boys**
- 3 pairs long trousers or jeans plus 2 pairs of shorts in summer - **Boys**
- 2 pairs of joggers (Trackie syle bottoms) - optional
- 4 tops and 4 pairs of trousers/jeans - **Girls**. 2 dresses or 2 skirts (or shorts) for summer – **Girls**
- 2 fleecy lined tracksuit type jackets or hoodies for cooler days and to wear indoors - **Boy and Girls**
