The Oratory Schools offer parents the following insurance schemes:

Your child will automatically be included in the Personal Accident insurance scheme.

AXA PPP require a correctly completed application form (contained in the explanatory leaflet on our website) – please ensure you tick part 2(a) of this form if you wish the School to be able to obtain authorisation for treatment or handle claims for your child.

Fees Refund Scheme

The Oratory Schools are also able to offer parents the opportunity to pay an additional termly charge to participate in their Fees Refund scheme, whereby you can obtain a proportionate refund of fees if your child is absent from school for periods of time due to illness or injury.
