



Uniform changes through the years

Moving from Nursery to Kindergarten.

Pre-Prep sports uniform needed. Appointment for uniform fitting optional.

Moving from to Kindergarten to Reception

Full Pre-Prep uniform needed. Appointment for uniform fitting advised.

Moving from Reception to Year 1

Games socks in school colours and mouth guard now needed. Optional base layers but must be school issue.

Moving from Year 1 to Year 2.

Girls will need hockey kit (including shin pads and mouth guard).

Boys will need rugby kit (including mouth guard) for Michaelmas term and shin pads for Lent term.

Boys and girls will need school issue base layers for Michaelmas and Lent term. Fitting appointments optional.

Moving from Year 2 to Year 3.

Prep uniform required. Appointment for uniform fitting advised.

Moving from Year 3 to Year 4.

Boys will need long white cricket trousers and abdo guard for Summer Term.

Moving from Year 4 to Year 5.

Boys can now have jammers in place of swim trunks.

Moving from Year 5 to Year 6.

Girls wear white ankle socks with summer uniform and opaque tights with winter uniform. Girls no longer need dance uniform. Girls will need cricket trousers for the summer term. All Year 6 children have the option of larger book bag. Boys go into long grey school trousers and short grey ankle socks.

Moving from Year 6 to Year 7.

Girls wear tartan school kilts for winter uniform.

Moving from Year 7 to Year 8.

No 1 uniform all year. Option of short sleeve shirt in summer for boys which can be purchased from any retailer. Girls wear $\frac{3}{4}$ sleeved reverse neck school blouses.
